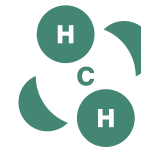

SPETT's Conference History

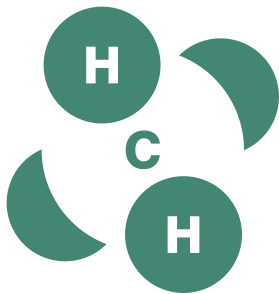


- LACPEC

 - Promotion of products and services



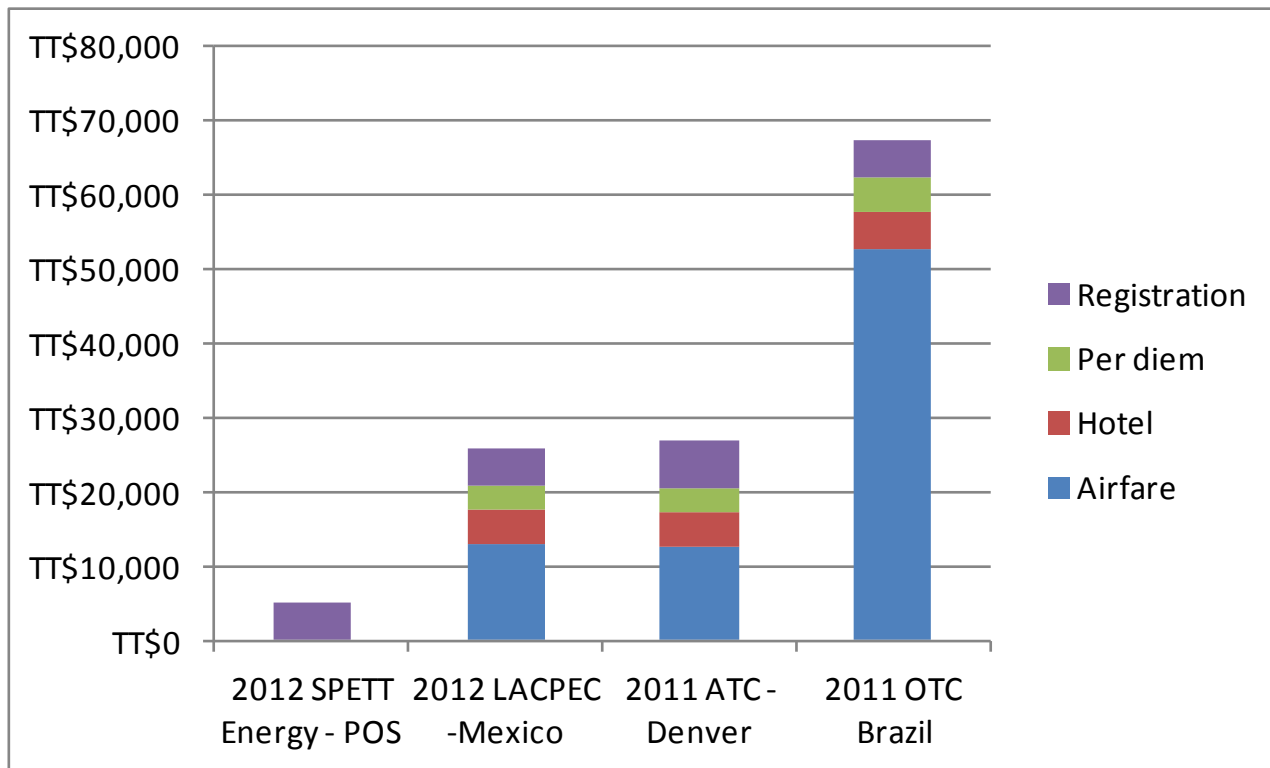

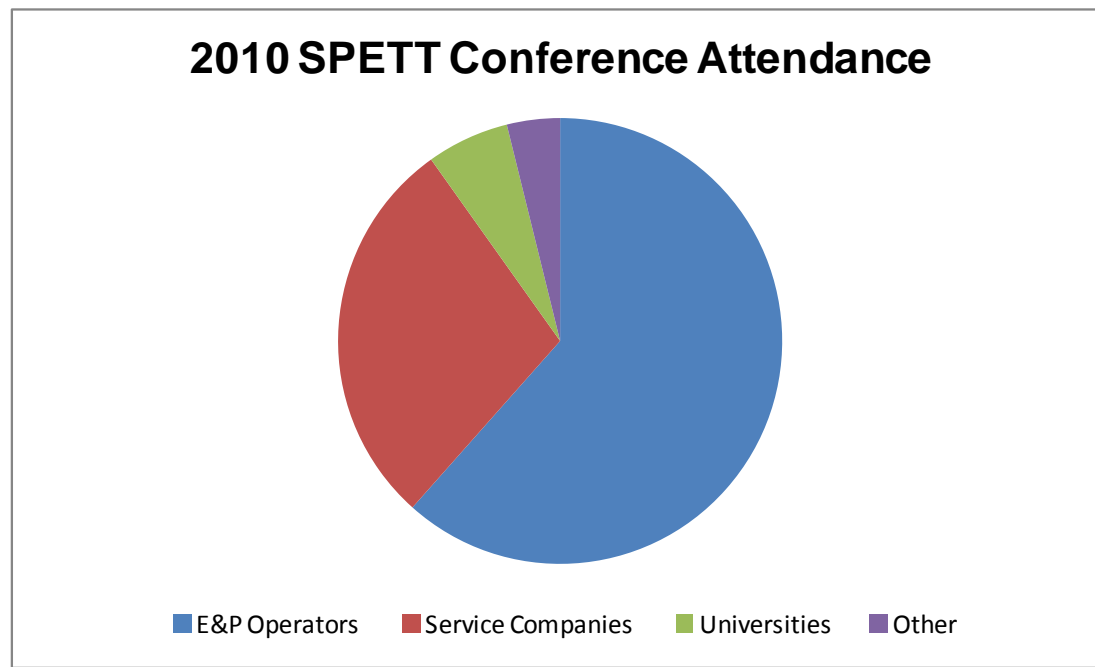
- Significantly reduced cost

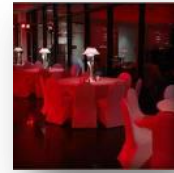

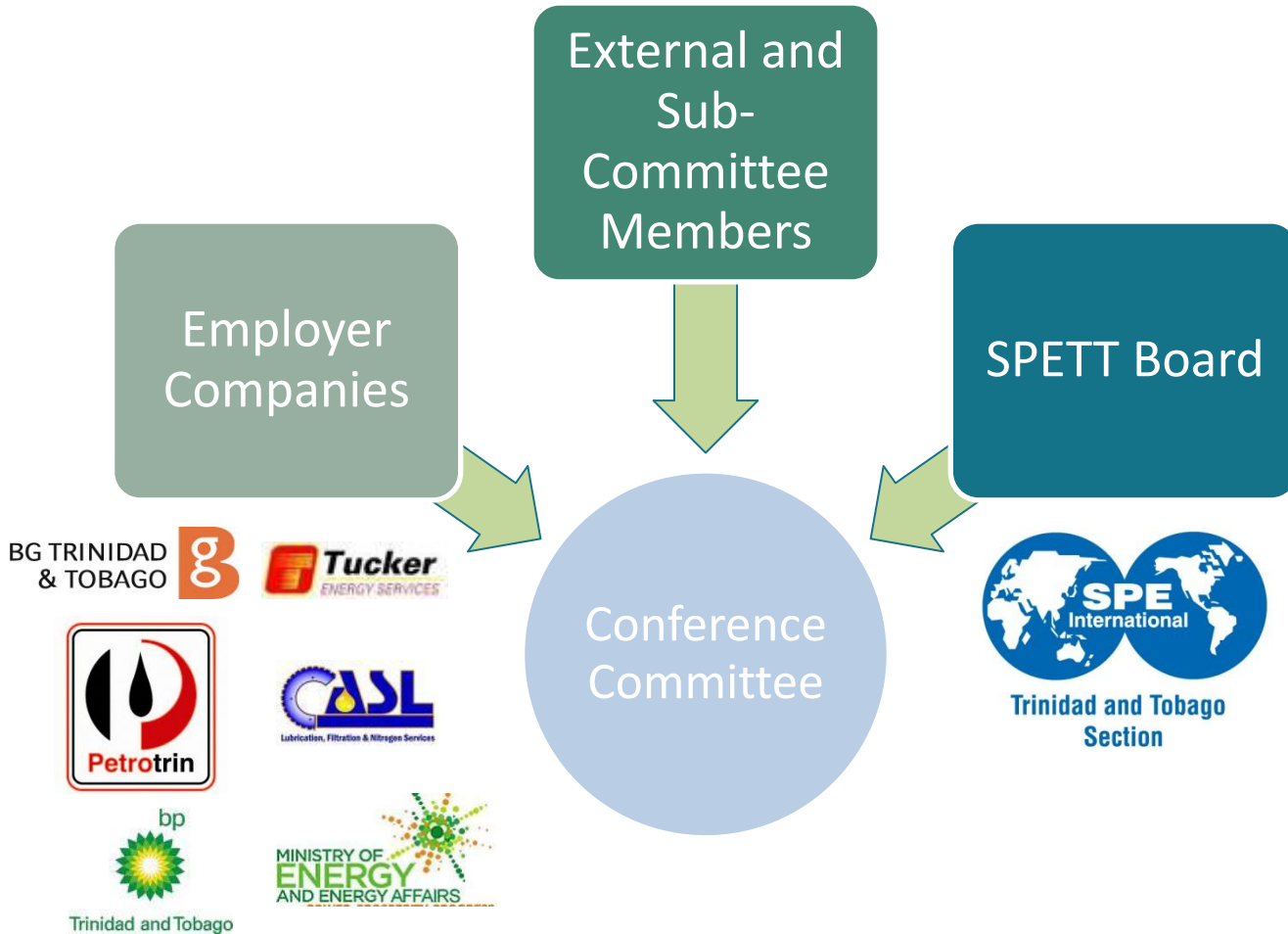
